RULES AND REGULATIONS

Check-In: 2:00pm

For the convenience of an early check-in, a nominal fee of \$15 applies.

Checkout: 11:00am

For the convenience of a late check-out, a nominal fee of \$15 applies.

General Store Hours: 9:00 AM – 6:00 PM Sun-Thu
9:00 AM – 8:00 PM Fri & Sat

Check with front office staff for October hours.

Quiet Hours: 10:00 PM – 8:00 AM. Please be considerate of your fellow campers. All visitors must register at the office and are asked to leave the grounds by 10 pm.

Reservations & Rates: Payment of 100% is due upon making reservation. Please review the Cancellation Policy.

Payments for reservations must be made with Credit/Debit cards. Cash is not accepted for reservations. Card transactions must be submitted online or at the front office. Card information cannot be taken over the phone.

Our base rate for RV Sites includes: 1 RV/trailer, 4 people and 1 vehicle.
Maximum (at additional charge for extras): 1 RV/Trailer, 8 people, 3 pets, and 2 vehicles.

Our base rate for Cabins includes: 4 people and 1 vehicle.
Maximum (at additional charge for extras): 4 people, 3 pets, and 2 vehicles.

Please contact us to make arrangements for additional vehicles, available if space permits.

- Extra vehicle fee \$10/night
- Additional Person fee \$10/night
- Pet fee for RVs/Tents \$5/night
- Pet fee for Cabin \$10/night

Campfires: Campfires are allowed only if fire danger levels in Garfield County permits! Campfires are permitted 8:00 AM to midnight and only in provided fire rings. Please never leave a campfire unattended, and ensure that fire is completely out before leaving your site or going to bed. Kindly inquire at the office regarding any current fire restrictions in place.

Picnic Tables and Fire Rings: All sites have a picnic table and a fire ring with a grate. Please do not move picnic tables or fire rings.

Bathhouse and Laundry Room: Open 24 hours. For human use only, no pets are allowed in the facilities. Elk Creek Campground is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen items.

Creek Usage: Guests may access East Elk Creek which runs through the property, however, accessing the creek is done at the guests own risk. There are no lifeguards on duty and the creek is changing constantly. Elk Creek Campground, Inc and Paqarina Ranch, LLC are not responsible for guests who choose to access the creek.

Fishing: Fishing the creek requires licensing per the Colorado Parks and Wildlife. All fishing from the campground property banks is **Catch and Release ONLY** and fishermen must use barbless hooks.

Hunting: Hunters may stay at the campground during hunting season. Hunting in Colorado requires licensing per the Colorado Parks and Wildlife. All game must be stowed in an enclosed compartment not visible to other guest while occupying a site at Elk Creek Campground.

Bear Country and Wildlife: YOU ARE IN BEAR COUNTRY! Please keep all trash and food secure, and do not feed the animals. Please take trash to dumpsters DAILY.

Firearms: Elk Creek Campground supports all law-abiding firearm owners and the possession of firearms in accordance with local, State and Federal law. Laws

regarding firearms shall be strictly enforced. Discharging ANY firearm within the campground is prohibited. No open/concealed carry, on site. All firearms must stay stowed in personal areas (vehicle/RV/cabin).

Restrictions: No fireworks, disorderly conduct, or other methods of inhibiting the good times of others. Any person who defaces, injures, or destroys campground property or equipment or whose children, pets or guests do so, will be held liable for the full cost of damages.

Pets: Pets are welcome at the campground as long as each pet is accompanied by a 6ft leash and an owner. Please do not leave your pet outside unattended. We have a designated pet park. Please use it and kindly pick up after your pets. Pets are not allowed in the Front Office, Bath House (restrooms & shower facility) and Laundry Facility. Please refrain from leaving pets unattended in RVs or Cabins for their safety and the comfort of other guests.

Children: Parents are responsible for their children at all times. If your child is under age 14 years old, they must have a parent with them at all times. All children must be to their sites by 10:00 PM.

Smoking: Smokers, please be considerate of your fellow campers and be sure to pick up your butts and put them in the garbage. Thank you for NOT smoking (of any kind) in ANY public building or cabin. Please do not smoke within 25 feet of any building. Please refrain from smoking marijuana of any kind on property.

Firewood: To prevent the spreading of firewood-related pests, please do not bring your own firewood. We have bundles available for purchase at the Elk Creek Campground store. Gathering of wood or cutting trees (including branches) is NOT permitted in the campground or on surrounding property.

Your Site & Etiquette: Please be mindful of your neighbors and do not walk through other people's camping sites. Remind your kids to do the same. Please stay on roads or walkways. Do not park your vehicles, bikes or ATV's on a vacant site.

Damages to RV Site, Cabin or Campground Property: Guest is liable for any damages done to campground property, and will be charged accordingly. Charge will be determined by the campground manager, not the guest.

Lost Key Fee: If a cabin key is misplaced or goes missing during a stay, there will be a \$25 key replacement fee charged to the account.

Garbage: Please be sure to bag all trash (including cigarette butts) and dispose of it in the dumpsters. You are responsible for your site's cleanliness. Trash must be disposed of daily.

Dishes: Please do not wash your dishes in the bathroom sinks, showers or creek. A dish washing station is available (seasonally) on the east side of the Bath House.

Generators: Thank you for not running a generator at any time. All campsites provide electricity at 20, 30, and 50 amp options so generators are prohibited except with permission from Elk Creek Campground management for unique circumstances.

Sewer Connection: A secure sewer connection is required at both ends of your sewer line by Colorado State Law.

Cabins: BBQ'ing shall always be outside the cabins. Please bring your own linens. All of our cabins are non-smoking.

Social Media Content: Content for social media outlets will be collected throughout the season. By agreeing to these rules and regulations, you consent to have your person/RV/vehicles featured on our social media pages. If you do not consent, and do not want your pictures featured, please inform front office upon Check-In or via email prior to arrival.
